

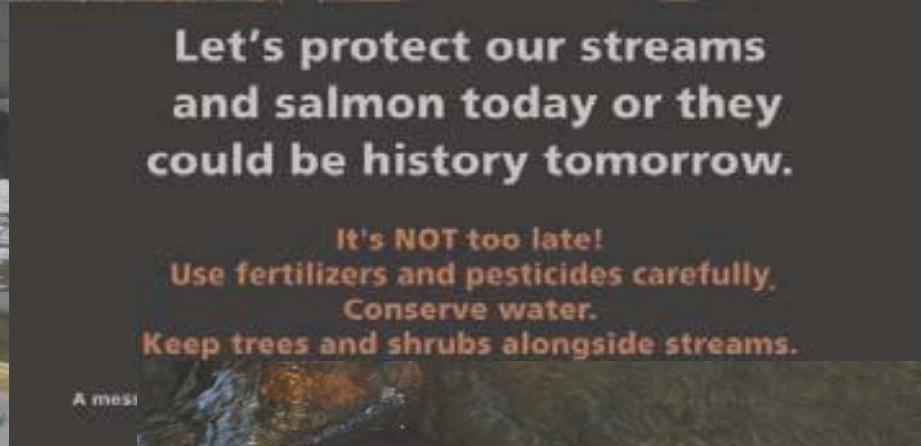

Reinventing Rainwater Management: A Blueprint for Action

Solution 1: Promote Rainwater Harvesting

Actions:

- Promote Decentralized Infrastructure to Harvest Rainfall
- Work with senior government to reduce legal and regulatory impediments to RWH

Reinventing Rainwater Management: A Blueprint for Action

Solution 2: (Re)Build It Better

Actions:

- Adjust Development Cost Charges
- Promote Implementation of LID Practices
- Identify Infrastructure Problems
- Repair and Replace
- Install “End of Pipe” Stormwater Treatment

Reinventing Rainwater Management: A Blueprint for Action

Solution 3: Good Governance for Stormwater

Actions:

- Create Integrated Watershed Management Plan
- Establish a Rainwater Commission
- Develop Performance-Based Regulations
- Legislate Content of Rainwater Management Plans
- Enhance Reporting
- Support Citizen-Driven Initiatives
